PROGRAM POLICIES

A. Attendance

Before a child can attend Faith Formation classes, parents will need to register him/her through the Faith Formation Office. Parents need to sign their child in and out of the classroom before and after each class. Regular class attendance is expected and mandatory. If your child misses 5 classes during either year of Sacramental Preparation, or any mandatory retreat day, a parent will need to meet with the Children's Faith Formation Minister to remain in the program. Any missed work is to be "made-up" and is the responsibility of both the parent and child.

B. Parental Involvement

Parental involvement is essential to the Faith Formation of their child. At your child's baptism, you made a promise to bring them up in the Faith, making you the primary educators in the faith of your child. We encourage you to become involved by:

1. Regular attendance at Mass as well as observing Holy Day's of Obligation.
2. Establish family rituals to celebrate the seasons of the Church at home.
3. Spending time with your child daily in prayer.
4. Make attending Mass and Faith Formation classes a priority in your family.
5. Volunteer to assist in the classroom or to help with special events during the year.
